

Dear Parents/Carers,

As our Year 5 children enter an extremely important year at the end of their primary school journey, it is important for them to have some shared experience at a residential to become secondary school ready. It is also important for them to be challenged, removed from their comfort zone and for them to face fears head on to fill them with confidence in the lead up to their end of Y6 SATs tests. Mr McNamara has sourced a quote from Kingswood activity center located in the Peak District.

The trip will take place Monday 25th September – Wednesday 27th (when the children start their new class in Y6) and will cost £80 per child. If you would like your child to attend, the deadline for money to be paid in full is Monday 3rd July and must be paid through parent pay.

If the amount is not paid in full, your child will not be able to attend. To secure your child's place, we ask for a deposit of £25 to be paid through parent pay by Friday 12th May.

The children will leave school at lunchtime on Monday to arrive at the center at 2:30pm. They will have an action packed trip of activities including archery, laser quest, high wire climbing and much more. The children will leave the center at around lunchtime on Wednesday to be back at school for normal end of school pick up time.

All activities will be led by trained activity leaders on site and all food is provided for the cost above (the children will eat 3 hot meals per day).

More details will be released regarding clothing/items needed and spending money etc. closer to the time.
