

Dear parent/carers,

It has been a very busy year but also a very rewarding one - whilst we still await a number of results from this year's statutory assessments I can confirm that 100% of our Year 1 children passed the phonics screening check and 94% of our Year 4 children scored an outstanding result on the multiplication test. This is a fantastic achievement and we are incredibly proud of our children and the hard work and commitment that they have shown, and we are confident that the remainder of the results will be just as pleasing. A huge well done to all!
