Scarborough Trip information:

Please arrive at school for **8:15** so we can complete the register, use the toilets and sort out lunches. We will be boarding the coach at **8:30** and **it will not wait for people that are running late.**

Before you come to school, please remember to apply sun cream lotion. Bring this with you so you can reapply it during the day.

Please wear a hat and bring plenty of water - it's likely to be very warm and you'll need to be drinking lots! Please ensure you only bring water, not fizzy drinks.

Please bring a small bag with you so you have something to put your lunch, drinks and sun cream lotion etc in. You can bring a towel/blanket with you to sit on that must fit in your bag.

Please wear your normal white school uniform top (you can bring your purple jumper/cardigan if you'd like to) as well as your normal black PE shorts/bottoms and a pair of trainers. So that you are easily recognisable on the beach in your white top and black bottoms, we are asking that you do not wear your Y6 Leavers hoodie to Scarborough as these are all different colours. (You can carry on wearing these like you have been doing at school though!)

You are allowed to bring some money with you if you wish so that you can purchase extra drinks, ice creams or buckets and spades etc while at the beach. If you choose to bring money (you don't have to!), we are recommending you bring £5. Please note: you will be responsible for looking after any money you bring so make sure it is in a secure purse/wallet within your bag. This is to make sure your money remains safely with you as teachers will be unable to look after the money that you bring.

If you have any buckets and spades at home, bring them along! (We will bring bats and balls from school so there's no need to bring them). As per the Academy's usual rules, we are not allowing mobile phones on the trip, but if you wish to bring something to keep you occupied on the coach journey (a book, a sketching pad, a card game etc), then please do!

We aim to be back at Littleworth for **4:30pm** and shall be in contact with the school office to update them on any traffic delays we may encounter. The school office will in turn let your grown-ups know about this.

We're very much looking forward to a fun-filled day where we celebrate you and everything you have worked so hard to achieve during your time at Littleworth!
